- \* Oral presentations for independent researchers will be for 30 minutes (including Q&A), trainee/student presentations will be 15 minutes (including Q&A).
- \* Original and new research is required. Submissions must not have been previously presented. Data and results should be completed. Expected data or results to be determined are not acceptable.
- \* Poster presentations will undergo a blind peer review.
- \* Industry submissions will be subject to a \$500 fee if accepted.
- \* All financial disclosures must be transparent.
- \* All presenters must register for the meeting by June 30.

Students are invited to apply for one of ten \$500 Travel Awards from Kids Brain Health Network (restrictions apply) and for one of two CADDRA Poster Awards.
